



Braham Area School District #314 Student/Parent Chromebook Agreement

As part of the 1:1 Chromebook initiative at Braham School District #314, the District will provide students with a Chromebook or similar electronic device for school work to use both at school and at home. To help the District and parents protect this investment, parents must select one of three options for covering accidental damage or theft prior to the deployment of the Chromebook or similar electronic device to your child.

Can students turn down the Chromebook and bring their own device?

Yes, as long as they agree to bring another Wi-Fi device that can access Google Apps - cell phone NOT acceptable.

Purchase Options

To assist students and parents in utilizing this option the District has procured the assistance of an independent merchant to provide a Chromebook at discounted prices.

- \$230 Personal Purchase** at school cost, working directly with Dell to bring educational pricing home to parents.
This purchase option is available only for students currently enrolled in the Braham Area School District.
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Insurance Agreement

Parents may choose to procure insurance to cover loss, theft or accidental damage of a District Chromebook or similar electronic device through one of three options:

- Personal Insurance - proof of insurance must be provided.**

Personal Insurance. Parents may choose to procure their own insurance at their own cost to protect the District provided Chromebook or similar electronic device in cases of theft, loss or accidental damage. Parents should consult their insurance agent about the availability of a personal insurance policy or a rider to an existing renter's or homeowner's policy. The replacement cost of the policy must be at least \$300. If you choose this option, proof of insurance must be provided to the District annually on or before June 1 and/or before your student(s) are provided with a Chromebook.

- \$30 per Year**

District Insurance. Parents may purchase insurance through the District. District insurance will protect Chromebooks or a similar electronic device against theft or accidental damage due to an act of nature (i.e.: fire, flood, water, etc.). The District will require that a police report be submitted in cases of theft. Fraudulent reporting of theft will be turned over to the police for prosecution. A student making a false report will also be subject to disciplinary action as outlined by the school discipline code. This insurance policy does not cover loss of the Chromebook and/or its accessories, cosmetic damage, or damages caused by intentional misuse and abuse. The District will assess parents the cost for repair and/or replacement if the damage is determined not to be accidental, if the device is lost or if the damage or loss is otherwise not within the protection guidelines. The cost for District insurance is \$30 annually.

- \$300 Refundable Damage Deposit.**

Parents who choose not to provide their student(s) with a personal electronic device or to obtain either personal insurance or insurance through the District must agree to pay for the repair or replacement of the Chromebook or similar electronic device and provide the District with an annual \$300 refundable deposit. The full deposit, less the cost for repair or replacement, if applicable, will be returned when the Chromebook is returned to the District in proper working order.

***Any deposit or fee for any student whose parent is serving in, or within the past year has served in, active military service as defined under Minnesota Statutes Section 190.05 or who is unable to pay the deposit or fee may be waived upon application to the District.*

A student who does not elect one of the foregoing options or whose District provided Chromebook is lost, stolen or damaged, may not be supplied with an original Chromebook or replacement Chromebook until either one of the foregoing options is selected and, in the case of repair or replacement, such repairs or replacements can be obtained. Any device replaced by the District will be subject to a new refundable deposit or insurance plan. In the interim, students will be provided with an alternative method of completing coursework. A student's right to use and possess the District Chromebook or similar electronic device as well as the use of the District's internet services on a personal device is subject to the District's Acceptable Use Policy. A student who violates this policy may lose the privilege to use a District Chromebook or District internet services and will be provided with an alternative method for completing coursework.

A student's right to possess the District Chromebook or similar electronic device terminates no later than the last day of classes during the school year unless terminated earlier by the District or upon the student's withdrawal from the District. A student who fails to timely return the Chromebook or similar electronic device or uses the Chromebook or District internet services for non-school purposes without the school's consent will be in unlawful possession of school property and appropriate legal action may be taken.

Parents/Guardians must initial a statement below and sign this Agreement before your child receives a device:

_____ I will provide personal insurance or a rider on my renters/homeowner's policy, at my own cost, for the repair and/or replacement value of the Chromebook or similar electronic device in an amount not less than \$300 and will provide proof of such insurance annually no later than June 1 and/or before my child is issued a District Chromebook or similar electronic device. I agree to timely and accurately complete any necessary claim forms as required by the insurer and to provide the District with copies of the completed claim forms. The District will be listed as a named insured on the policy/rider. If the property is stolen, I agree to immediately file a police report. I will notify the District of the loss, damage or theft of the property no later than the next school day after the occurrence. I further understand that fraudulent reporting of theft will be turned over to the police and may subject my child to disciplinary action pursuant to the school discipline code. I understand and agree that to the extent any damage to the Chromebook or similar electronic device is not covered by the insurance I procure, I will be responsible to the District for the cost of repairing and/or replacing the device up to a maximum of \$300 per device. I further understand that the District will procure the necessary repairs and/or replacement of the device and that I will be billed for these costs to the extent these costs are not covered by my insurance.

_____ I will pay the District for an insurance plan for repair or replacement of the Chromebook or similar electronic device. I will pay the annual or semester fee of \$30 annually. I agree to timely and accurately complete any necessary claim forms as required by the insurer. If the property is stolen, I agree to immediately file a police report. I will notify the District of the loss, damage or theft of the property no later than the next school day after the occurrence. I further understand that fraudulent reporting of theft will be turned over to the police and may subject my child to disciplinary action pursuant to the school discipline code. I understand and agree that to the extent any damage to the Chromebook or similar electronic device is not covered by the insurance I procure, I will be responsible to the District for the cost of repairing and/or replacing the device up to a maximum of \$300 per device. I further understand that the District will procure the necessary repairs and/or replacement of the device and that I will be billed for these costs to the extent these costs are not covered by my insurance.

_____ I choose not to procure personal insurance or insurance through the District. Instead, I agree to provide the District with an annual refundable deposit in an amount not to exceed \$300. I understand that if the District Chromebook or similar electronic device is not returned to the District or is returned to the District in damaged condition, all or part of my deposit will not be refunded. I understand that if the District Chromebook must be repaired or replaced while in my possession the school year, I will be required to provide the District with an additional refundable deposit.

_____ I am applying for a waiver of one of the foregoing charges/deposits. I understand that to the extent I do not timely submit a waiver application or qualify for a waiver, I will be responsible for one of the foregoing charges/deposits.

I have read, understand and agree to the above terms and conditions related to my child's use of a Chromebook or similar electronic device.
